

# Durham Automobile Club Ltd

## Supplementary Regulations for Weardale 12 Car Navigational Rally

1 – Durham Automobile Club Ltd will organise a Clubsport Permit 12 Car Navigational Rally on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> March 2010 starting at Mickleton Service Station, Mickleton, Co Durham (92/973237). This rally is aimed at ABSOLUTE beginners and NO competition licence is required, it will run behind the Weardale Navigational Rally

2 – The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the MSA (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations.

3 – MSA Permit No 56859 has been issued.

4 – The event is open to all fully elected and paid up members of the organising club, and invited clubs.

All competitors must produce a current Club Membership Card.

5 – Event is open to all vehicles that comply with R18.3.3 and R18.5 and R18.6

6 – The programme of the event will be:

Scrutineering opens	17.00 hours.
Signing-on opens	17.00 hours.
Signing on closes	18.30 hours.
First car "CAR 0" will start	19.00 hours.

7 – Scheduled Timing will be used throughout the event (R12.1 and R12.2). All sections will be Standard Sections unless otherwise stated. Timing will be by marshals' official clocks. All times and distances will be deemed correct and not subject to protest, in the event of a time piece failure, then the control will assume the status of a PC. Maximum lateness will be 30 minutes.

Time Controls (TCs) will be identified by a Control Board, and time given will be the time the Control Board is passed. Route Check Code Boards (RCCBs), or manned Passage Controls (PCs) may be used in accordance with R11.3 and R11.4 to ensure compliance with the correct route, which is defined as the shortest route that complies with all instructions, unless otherwise stated. RCCBs must be recorded correctly to be deemed valid, PCs will be identified by a Control Board, and competitors will be required to stop and obtain the marshal's signature.

Quiet, Caution and No Boards may be deployed, their purpose is self-explanatory. Samples of all Boards will be available at the start.

The total length of the event is approximately 90 miles using public roads.

O.S. 1:50000 Landranger Sheet 92 Edition C1 and Sheet 87 Edition D are required and any feature of the map or borders or cover may be used to define the route.

8 – The running order will be at the discretion of the organisers. Provisional competition numbers may be advised in the Final Instructions, but they may be subject to last-minute revisions if late entries are received and accepted.

Identification numbers will be supplied by the organisers at signing on, and must be affixed in accordance with R6.1 i.e. one on the near side window and one on the rear window of the car

9 – The event will comprise of one class:  
Beginners

10 –The entry list opens on receipt of these S.R. and close on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2010. The entry fee is £15.00, any entries accepted after the closing date is subject to a £10.00 surcharge. All entries must be made on the Official Entry Form and accompanied by the entry fee.

The Secretary of the Meeting to whom entries should be sent is **John Wood, 58 Thorndale Road, Durham, DH1 2AH**, Phone 0191 3846586, e-mail soc.jwood@btopenworld.com Final Instructions and Results will be sent by e-mail if address is supplied, if you have no e-mail address please supply 2 S.A.E.s for Final Instructions and Final Results. **All crews must send a copy of maps 92 and 87 with your entry, to enable them to be marked up.**

The maximum entry for the event is 12, and the minimum is 3. Entries will be selected in order of receipt.

11 – Marking and penalties will be as written in Appendix 1 Chart 13, except as modified or clarified below:

Per minute late at a Time Control	1 minute.
Per minute early at a Time Control	2 minutes.
Not reporting, or reporting OTL to a Time Control	30 minutes.
Entering, leaving or passing through any control in the wrong direction	15 minutes.
Failure to record a Passage Control or Code Board correctly	15 minutes.
The time given to a competitor is the time he passes the Control Board	

12 –Driving Standards Observers (DSOs) may be appointed to ensure compliance with R8.1. DSOs may not be identified as such and competitors will not be required to stop by a DSO, unless he or she is also acting in another capacity e.g. a Control of some kind.

In Quiet Zones competitors will be expected to drive with care, without auxiliary lights and in the highest practicable gear.

13 – In the event of a tie, the winner will be the furthest clean. If this does not resolve the tie, the earliest received entry will be the winner, if the tie is still not resolved then the crew with the smallest engine capacity will be declared the winner.

14 – Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with C5.1 to C5.7.

15 – An award will be presented for 1<sup>st</sup> overall.

17 – All vehicles must be insured for use on the public highway. The insurer's name must be stated on the Entry Form, and proof of cover must be produced at signing-on, unless using the Lockton scheme. Durham Automobile Club Ltd has applied to Lockton for a Blanket Cover Note under the Motor Sports Club Scheme. This will provide competitors who need to use the scheme with the Third Party Cover necessary to meet RTA requirements. Applicants for the scheme must be able to comply with the following items: -

- A – Over 21 and held a full licence for at least 6 months.
- B – Not more than 1 fault accident in the last 3 years.
- C – No more than a maximum of 6 speeding points on licence.
- D – No physical or mental disabilities.
- E – No other material facts.

Any person unable to comply will be required to complete a Declaration Form prior to the event to allow sufficient time for a Letter of acceptance to be issued.

It should be noted that the Lockton scheme imposes an excess of £250.
